How to Write a Book in Four Weeks

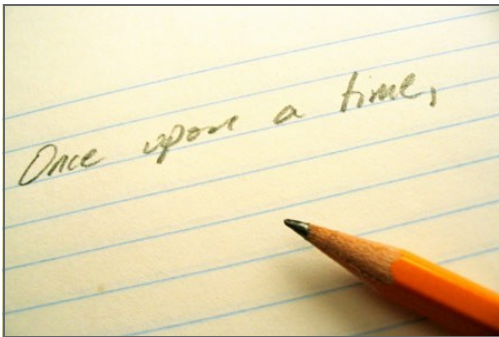
Do you have a book inside you?

Championship Marriage Seminar

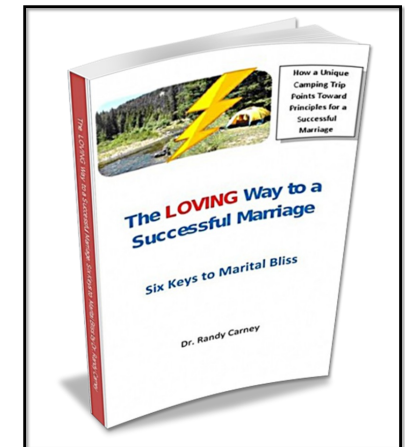
Don't just be *in* the marriage game. Go for the championship!
